Notification of the Department of Special Investigation

on Resolution of the Board of Special Case to Accept Unlisted Criminal Offences as Special Cases

The Board of Special Case (BSC) convened the meeting no. 1/2566 on 15 February 2023 and passed, by unanimity of its existing members and in accordance with Section 21 paragraph one (2) in conjunction with Section 10 (3) of the Special Case Investigation Act, B.E. 2547 (2004), a resolution to accept unlisted criminal offences as special cases to be investigated under the Special Case Investigation Act, B.E. 2547 (2004) as follows:

1. The case in which members of the public in Bueng Kan Province were deceived into entering into hire-purchase contracts for motorcycles;

2. The case in which the Department of National Parks, Wildlife and Plant Conservation requested an investigation into the incident where officers of Sirinat National Park in Phuket Province found backhoe clearing and barbed wire fencing around the area of Sirinat National Park, whereas it is believed that the Sor Khor 1 document (for No. 283 Moo 1 Saku Sub-district, Thalang District, Phuket Province) which was presented does not correspond with the actual land plot;

3. The case in which the Economic Crime Suppression Division requested legal actions against Asia Plantation Capital Holdings Co., Ltd. and accomplices for public fraud and offences under the Emergency Decree on Borrowings which are Regarded as Public Cheating and Fraud, B.E. 2527 (1984).
