Notification of the Department of Special Investigation

on Resolution of the Board of Special Case to Accept Unlisted Criminal Offense as Special Case

The Board of Special Case convened the meeting no. 1/2569 on 9 April 2026 and passed a resolution, in accordance with Section 21 paragraph one (2), in conjunction with Section 10 (3) of the Special Case Investigation Act, B.E. 2547 (2004) and its amendments, and by a majority vote of not less than two-thirds of all existing members, to accept one unlisted criminal offense as a special case to be investigated under the Special Case Investigation Act, B.E. 2547 (2004) as follows:

The cases concerning criminal offenses related to fuel oil as defined by the law on fuel oil trading, which are impacted by the conflict in the Middle East and which involve actions committed by fuel traders under Section 7 or Section 10, or any fuel traders regardless of whether they are legally registered or not, conducted as an organized network, involving complexity, or causing severe impact on the public or the industrial sector, starting from March 1, 2026, onwards, until the conflict in the Middle East subsides.
